Sun Cream Reminder- We have decided on the following;

<u>Blossom Room</u>- Please ensure you put sun cream on your child before they arrive at nursery. Please also provide a named, bottle of sun cream in your child's bag so that their key person can reapply during the day. We have decided to ask for individual bottles to be brought in as in the past, many children required different brands of cream for various reasons.

<u>Nursery School-</u>Like in Blossom room please ensure your child arrives in nursery with sun cream on. During the day we will reapply another coat.

We will provide our own bottles of cream but we would like to ask for a voluntary **donation of £1** or **£2** from parents, to help us cover the costs of the cream. A donation box can be found in the entrance hall or ask at the office.

If your child is allergic to certain types of cream then please bring in their own named bottle of cream for us to keep at nursery.

Hats- we have a big selection of hats at nursery and we will expect each child to wear one in the garden. If your child would rather wear their own hat then please bring one in and make sure it is named.
