Childcare Admissions Policy and T & C's- We have updated our admissions policy. A new version can now be found on our website. There has been a slight alteration in the ranking criteria where we have removed the distance lived at between the school and home address.

With regard to our terms and conditions for existing customer priority **change/cancellation of booking** now need to be handed in at the office by the end of the second week of each large term (3 times a year). After this period of priority any spaces would then be offered to the waiting list. The new booking will then commence

at the start of the following large term. You can cancel or change your sessions at any other time by giving 2 calendar months written notice but any additional required sessions will be subject to availability. All existing bookings will be carried forward to the next term unless cancelled. If you have any questions, please ask or email the office.
