Routines and reminders;

- **Named clothing** Please name all your child's clothing to ensure a safe return if it comes off during the session.
- Waterproofs and wellies- Please ensure your child has a pair of NAMED wellies and a jacket at nursery for when we go outside to play. These can be left with us, in the group tub, so your child is ready to play outdoors.
- Late arrivals- If you arrive late for one reason or another then please ensure you have filled in a slip at the office so that we can ensure your children are registered for H&S purposes.

- **Absences**-It is important that you let us know if your child will not be coming into nursery. Either email us or call us. If we have not heard from you, then Chelsea will probably give you a call.
- **NO** food in Nursery- You should have noticed our NO NUTS signs up in nursery. This is because we have a couple of children who have food allergies. Please also ensure that your child doesn't eat any snacks in the nursery, before or at the end of the session to help us to ensure this is a safe environment for all our children.

Autumn Planting- We are planning to do some planting this month in the Nursery and Blossom Room gardens, and are looking for any donations to help us out! We are looking for donations of spring flowering bulbs and winter bedding, such as Pansies. If you can help us out, we would be really grateful.





Book Project- We are on a mission in the Nursery School to have a BIG revamp and sort out of our books. As part of this project we are looking at purchasing some new texts as well as making our reading environment cosy and accessible. Over the next few weeks we may be asking for help to raise some money to support this project. Harvest at Grandpont



Tuesday 1st October

On this day we will be celebrating 'Harvest' at Grandpont.



We will be pressing apples to make our own juice and making a collection of food that we will then donate to the Oxford Gatehouse, that exists to provide a calm and safe refuge for the homeless or vulnerably homed.

- **Some apples** for pressing! Windfalls, apples going over or whatever you can bring so we can let all of the children have a go at making some juice.
- A bottle to collect the juice in. Please ensure this is named. It can be a drink bottle or a water bottle of any kind. This will allow the children to take their juice home to share with you.
- Food donations for our harvest table. The food we like to receive are things like Salad, Fruit, Bread, Cakes, Sugar, Tea, Coffee, Sugar, Tuna, Margarine, Mayo, Ketchup, Salad cream, Squash, Tinned food, Branston pickle, Marmite, Chocolate spread.

We will be making the juice in the garden and each group will have the opportunity to talk about the food donations and sing some harvest songs. It should be lots of fun!
