You will then notice that we have been very considerate towards parents requests for healthy options and will be providing meals that are nutritionally balanced for the age group who we are feeding. We currently have many families who request no puddings or no cake, which we would like to avoid as we will be providing a menu that we hope you feel happy with your children eating.



**Summer safe-**Please ensure your children all have a NAMED hat in nursery this term and we will ensure they wear it in the garden. We will also apply sun cream and ask for a £1 donation towards the cost. Please leave your donation with Chelsea in the office.



We also want to allow the children to play in the woods as much as possible this term. We recommend that children have either some long trousers or wellies in nursery to avoid stings and brambles should they choose to go in the woods.

**Nursery Photographer-** The nursery photographer will be at Grandpont on Wednesday 1st May in the morning and Thursday 2nd May in the afternoon. Please let your child's key person know if you do not want their picture taking. If a picture is taken, there is no obligation to make a purchase.
