https://files.ofsted.gov.uk/v1/file/50139633 a copy of our latest OFSTED report for our childcare setting which was inspected on the 12th December 2019. If you would like a paper copy please ask a member of staff for one.

The judgement of the report was 'requires improvement' which we are disappointed with. However the report celebrates many positive and wonderful attributes of our Blossom Room setting.

We have been unpicking the areas for improvement and written an action plan to address these issues. Lynne has already put some new strategies in place and we will be working hard to ensure a better outcome at our next inspection. We will be expecting another visit from OFSTED in 6-12 months time.

Lynne and I would like to discuss the implications of the report in more detail with you. we will hold a couple of drop in sessions for you to come and chat and ask questions on **Thursday 16th January from 5.00-6.00pm** and on **Monday 20th January between 8.00am and 9.30am**. I would also like to take this opportunity to say **Thank you** for the huge amount of support and encouragement you have shared with us since the report was published.

**Routines and reminders-** It is always good at the start of a new term to remind yourselves of these things;

- **Named clothing** Please name all your child's clothing to ensure a safe return if it comes off during the session.
- **Waterproofs and wellies-** Please ensure your child has a pair of NAMED wellies and a jacket at nursery for when we go outside to play. These can be left with us, in the group tub, so your child is ready to play outdoors. We regularly go into our woodland area and we require the children to wear wellies when they play here.
- **Late arrivals-** If you arrive late for one reason or another then please ensure you have filled in a slip at the office so that we can ensure your children are registered for H&S purposes.
- **Absences**-It is important that you let us know if your child will not be coming into nursery. Either email us or call us. If we have not heard from you, then the office will probably give you a call.
- **NO food in Nursery-** You should have noticed our NO NUTS signs up in nursery. This is because we have a couple of children who have food allergies. Please also ensure that your child doesn't eat any snacks in the nursery, before or at the end of the session to help us to ensure this is a safe environment for all our children
- **Car Park-** The car park is for staff only during the day. However, if you are collecting your child by car after 3.45pm then you are more than welcome to drive into the car park to collect.
- **Parking on the road-** Please ensure you park in an appropriate parking space on the road, to ensure safety and avoid congestion.
